To Whom It May Concern:

Thank you for your interest in the semi-professional New England Football League, a non-profit organization sanctioned by Minor League Football News and recognized by the N.C.A.A. as a true amateur adult football league. Over the previous twenty one years, the N.E.F.L. has become one of the largest, most successful and competitive semi-pro, minor football leagues in the United States, consisting of over 3000 players and 58 teams. The 2015 season promises to be an even more prosperous venture, thanks mainly to the support of the many people and local businesses in the numerous communities that have shown an interest in our organization.

The New England Football League is for men eighteen years of age and older and operates under N.C.A.A. rules with certain modified rules to further enhance play. The N.E.F.L. consists of three conferences, the Maritime Conference (A), the North Atlantic Conference (AA) and the Colonial Conference (AAA) with either 45, 55 or 65 players on each team depending on the conference, and a coaching staff. Games are played throughout Massachusetts, Vermont, New Hampshire, Rhode Island, Connecticut, Maine, New York and New Jersey during the months of July through November. All N.E.F.L. games will be worked by five game officials and will be played in the presence of a certified E.M.T. and two athletic trainers. All teams in the N.E.F.L. also carry liability insurance which is included in their league fee, and player insurance is also available for those individuals interested in purchasing it.

The N.E.F.L. also offers a developmental division (N.E.F.L. 2) which is designed to be a cost effective way to develop teams and/or players for the N.E.F.L., and a collegiate division, the Yankee Collegiate Football Conference (Y.C.F.C.), which affords the opportunity for collegiate club football teams to participate in the league.
