(N.E.F.L. Collegiate)

In September 2010, the N.E.F.L. introduced the Yankee Collegiate Football Conference (YCFC). The collegiate conference is designed specifically for college and university club level type football programs that do not currently have a structured and organized league to participate in. In addition to being the first league of its type to be recognized as a true men's adult amateur football league by the N.C.A.A., the N.E.F.L. will now also be the first league of its type in the country to offer this level of play to colleges and universities. The N.E.F.L. will provide liability insurance (if needed) for each team, as well as scheduling of all games and certified game officials. By implementing the same format that our organization has used to great success over the past twenty one years, the collegiate conference allows student athletes to continue playing football in a positive and rewarding environment. This also creates a future player base for our teams by introducing these players to the N.E.F.L. so when they are done playing college football they can continue to participate in an organization that they are already familiar with.

The Yankee Collegiate Football Conference is also a proud member of the Intercollegiate Club Football Federation (ICFF), the national governing body of collegiate club football in the United States.
