

REGIONAL/NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP TOURNAMENT

The Harvest Bowl Regional Tournament, organized and operated by the North American Football Association (N.A.F.A.), invites annually the top four teams from the northeast region of the United States consisting of the N.E.F.L. "AAA" champion, as well as the champions from the Eastern Football League, the Empire Football League and the Five Star Football League to participate in a tournament to determine a northeast regional champion at the national level.

The Harvest Bowl Champion would then have the opportunity to participate in one of the championship games during "National Bowl Week", organized and operated by the United State Football Association (USFA) that is held in Florida in January, which determines an overall national champion.
